Early Education and Training Centres

Provide early intervention for children aged from birth to six with developmental delay, and support service to their families.

Special Child Care Centres

Provide daily training to children aged from two to six with physical and / or mental handicaps, visual / hearing impairment or autism.

Parents Resource Centres

Provide places where parents can turn to when they first learn of their child's handicap, and on through the years as they face the tasks of bringing up their handicapped child.

Child Care Centre

Provides young children with quality pre-school education aiming at the promotion of their holistic development.

Occasional Child Care Service

Provides temporary day care service for handicapped children and their siblings whose parents need temporary relief or have to attend to personal affairs.

Special Training for Autistic Children

Provides specialized training to autistic children and guidance to their parents as well as those schools / organizations with such children.

Supportive Learning Project

Provides a comprehensive range of therapeutic / psychological service to children and youth with learning difficulties as well as supportive programmes to their parents and teachers.

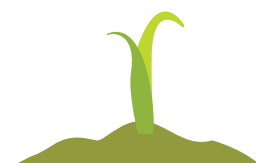

Heep Hong began as a small single-service agency 40 years ago. The first Special Child Care Centre (SCCC) was established with Social Welfare Department subventions in early 1970s, followed by the Early Education and Training Centres (EETC) in the 1980s. Heep Hong also spearheaded the parental movement and pioneered the Parents Resource Centre concept in early 1990s. Another breakthrough took place in 2000 with the introduction of the Supportive Learning Project, which expanded Heep Hong's scope of service to primary school students with learning difficulties. Last year, the first mixed-mode Centre (SCCC cum EETC) was set up with brand new rehabilitation concepts and designs. Heep Hong owes much of its success to the unswerving support of its staff, Committee members and advisers, volunteers and donors. I extend to them my sincere gratitude and wish the Society greater success in the years to come.

As one of Hong Kong's largest service providers of early education and intervention for children with special needs, Heep Hong has, throughout the past forty years, been committed to maintaining the highest level of service and catering to the community's changing needs. Such commitment witnesses the development of Heep Hong and the expansion of its services. What started originally as a small voluntary service for children recovering from polio has now become a renowned professional organization in the sector.

Like any other social service organization in Hong Kong, Heep Hong faced many changes over the past few years. The social welfare reforms introduced by the Social Welfare Department accompanied by rapid changes in the political, social, economic and technological environment have posed many challenges to us. Unavoidably, we are experiencing a rather tough period with shrinking funding support, increased competition aggravated by a low birth rate as well as rising aspirations and expectations from service users, sponsors and donors.

To cope with these challenges of the New Millennium, Heep Hong has undergone a paradigm shift and developed new ways to



Director's Report

Over the past 40 years, Heep Hong has helped nurture thousands of children with different abilities and contributed substantially to creating a more inclusive society. Through good times and bad, we strive to provide learning opportunities for children who have difficulties in adjusting to the "normal" educational environment. Hong Kong has been facing considerable change and uncertainty in the past few years, and like other welfare organizations we are experiencing a great deal of turbulence and confusion. We are constantly challenged to find new and more effective ways to deliver our services. The period under review witnessed our quest for innovation in an increasingly competitive community to gain our share of public resources and recognition.

Heavier workloads and public accountability have combined to push non-profit organizations to adopt a more business-like approach to their everyday activities. In our endeavour for professionalism, we learn and adapt some useful management techniques from the private sector such as strategic planning, marketing and customer service, financial analysis, strategic human resource management. This year, we formulated our annual plan based on the Balanced Scorecard framework which provides a balanced perspective to measure organizational performance. To encourage full participation from staff at all levels, workshops were organised to

在工作量不斷增加及公眾對問責訴求日增的情況下，非牟利團體均趨向以企業的營運模式來管理日常工作。為貫徹追求卓越的專業精神，我們向私營企業借鏡，引入他們一些有效的管理技巧，其中包括策略性規劃、市場推廣與顧客服務、財務分析，以及人力資源策略管理等。本會在訂定本年度的周年計劃時，以平衡計分法為藍本，從而為機構的表現作多方面的客觀分析。為鼓勵各階層同工的參與，我們更安排了多個工作坊，向他們簡介周年計劃的具體內容，以及鼓勵他們發表個人意見。本會未來的策略方向和目標已獲執行委員會通過，涵蓋層面包括機構整體、轄下各中心以至個人方面，讓全體員工能為邁向共同的目標而努力。當全體同工對本會的使命有透徹的瞭解，並能落實執行，管理層便能更容易推出各項新政策以提升機構的運作效率。

在二零零二年，本會參與了由獎券基金贊助，香港社會服務聯會統籌的「聯合業務改進計劃」，就「管理審核機制」及「人力資源管理」兩個範疇進行檢討。前者的目的是要為

introduce the business plan to them and staff were invited to give feedback on its implementation. The strategic directions and objectives, endorsed by the Board, are cascaded from the corporate to the centre and individual levels, thus ensuring the alignment of objectives and initiatives among these three levels. With a shared vision, which is thoroughly understood and followed throughout the organization, management is able to unleash many new policies conducive to effective operation.

In 2002, Heep Hong participated in joint-Business Improvement Projects on Management Audit System and Human Resource Management, which were supported by the Lotteries Fund and coordinated by the Hong Kong Council of Social Service. The former aimed at developing a self-administered assessment system to give early warning signals on managing risks while the latter helped to upgrade the staff's performance management system. The professional consultants employed for these two Projects conducted in-depth surveys on the 17 participating agencies. Reports revealed that Heep Hong is a well-run organization with many control systems in place and followed. Both consultants believed that staff members in general were satisfied with the recent organizational reforms and were ready to take on new challenges in strategic, financial, operational as well as human resources management in making Heep Hong an organization capable of meeting the changing social need and heightened customer expectations.

To excel in the current environment, we have to move with the times through continuous learning and the acquisition of knowledge. Heep

要在現時的环境維持優質服務，我們必須與時並進，透過持續學習來吸取新知識。由於我們所提供的是專業服務，所以十分依賴同工的專門知識，是以本會一直視員工為機構的重要資產。自從社會福利署實施整筆撥款政策後，我們便能彈性地将更多的資源投放在員工的發展與知識的管理上。為配合知識型經濟所帶來的挑戰，機構必須不斷推陳出新才可以逆境求存。在本會眾多的發展範疇中，其中一項重要的計劃就是透過內聯網發展有效的知識管理系統。另我們亦發展了一套「服務管理資訊系統」，使我們能更有效地整合及簡化服務策劃、提供及評估的流程。事實上，在過去兩年，我們已花了不少人力物力來加強本會的資訊科技建設。資訊科技小組亦已訂定周詳的計劃及長遠的策略目標，以提高本會的運作效率及提升服務質素。



Hong provides very specialized services which require expert knowledge in our daily work. Staff members are always considered as the most valuable asset of Heep Hong. Since the implementation of the Lump Sum Grant we have been able to deploy more resources in staff development and knowledge documentation. In the face of mounting challenges in a knowledge based economy, innovation is the only long term sustainable solution to survival. Among the many business initiatives, one of our most important plans is to establish a sound knowledge management system through the intranet platform. A Service Management Information System has been developed to better integrate and streamline the service planning, delivery and evaluation processes. In the past two years, much effort and funds have been spent on strengthening the Information Technology (IT) infrastructure in Heep Hong. Our Working Group on IT have formulated a long term strategy which sets out the blue print on how to better leverage IT to manage our operations and deliver high quality services.

All these achievements do not come easily. It is the result of a concerted effort and commitment from a multiplicity of constituencies, including staff, funders, volunteers, service users and the board of directors. Notwithstanding the growing uncertainty in our society, honest and frequent communications throughout the organization about these changes are vital in the pursuit of excellence. My annual meetings with the parents and frontline staff at each of the centre have provided a useful platform for mutual exchange and understanding. They welcomed such genuine participation in the change process and felt that they have a voice in designing the change and can exercise some control in the implementation. As we celebrate our 40th Anniversary, I take pride, along with an outstanding team of staff, to pledge our determination in making Heep Hong the preferred organisation for parents in their search for the best care for their children with special needs.



Report on Service Development

機構服務報告



During the year under review, Heep Hong has continued to strengthen its services for children, families and the community whereas the expansion of the Supportive Learning Project and the training programmes across the border have been implemented with encouraging results.

Service Expansion

In 2002, Heep Hong was successful in bidding for the operation of the first Special Child Care Centre (SCCC) cum Early Education and Training Centre (EETC) in Hong Kong. Using the theme of "Little World", this new mixed-mode Centre at Fu Cheong Estate is decorated with creative and interactive design features. It provides a wide variety of special training facilities, such as playroom, multi-sensory room, climbing wall and tree house. Children can find lots of fun and benefit from this stimulating learning environment.

With the EETC and SCCC services housed under the same roof, the staff's diversified expertise and experience can be pooled together to offer a whole range of specialized core training programmes to

suit the needs of the full spectrum of disabilities. This kind of cross-service fertilization enables a child to participate in a wider variety of training activities / programmes that best fit his / her needs. Parents welcome this new service mode and they are impressed with the progress children made in such a short period.

Acknowledging the service need at Tung Chung, the Social Welfare Department (SWD) invited Heep Hong to run a mini mixed-mode centre, with 18 SCCC and 30 EETC places, as an extended service unit of Tai Wo Hau SCCC and Cheung Ching EETC. In early February 2003, a site was identified at Yat Tung Estate (Phase II). To provide one-stop comprehensive service for children and parents, Heep Hong will also establish a Parents Resource Centre (PRC) at the same premises, to serve the whole of Lantau Island. The Centre is expected to commence operation by the end of 2003.

Upgrading of Centre Facilities

To solve the longstanding congestion problem of our Wanchai SCCC, Heep Hong, with support from SWD, has rented an additional flat adjacent to the existing Centre. With the expansion in space, a multi-sensory room, a multi-purpose room, two small training rooms and a resource and toy library were set up within the Centre in late 2002. In addition, major renovations were also carried out at Leung King and Pak Tin EETCs. In line with the policy of provision of centre-based speech therapy service, a properly equipped speech therapy room has been set up in each EETC. It is our aim to help children of different abilities to reach their full potential in a happy and healthy environment.

能在同一會址內同時提供早期教育及訓練中心與特殊幼兒中心的服務，有助匯集同工各方面的專業知識及豐富經驗來訂定一系列的核心課程。這種混合模式的服務亦能讓兒童有機會參與更多元化的訓練和活動，以切合他們的個別需要。雖然新中心運作僅半年，家長對學童的進步深感滿意。

鑑於東涌居民對早期教育服務的需求甚殷，社會福利署遂邀請本會於該區開辦另一所以混合模式運作的新中心。雖然該中心的規模較小，但亦能為區內兒童提供十八個特殊幼兒中心及三十個早期教育及訓練中心的學額，足以緩和太窩口特殊幼兒中心和長青早期教育及訓練中心現時緊張的服務需求。於二零零二年二月初，中心選址終確定於東涌逸東樓二期。為了讓有需要的兒童及其家長獲得全面的一站式服務，該中心亦將附設家長資源中心，以服務大嶼山區內的居民，並期望能在二零零三年年底正式啟用。

中心設施質量的改善

為了舒緩灣仔特殊幼兒中心長久以來的擠迫情況，在社會福利署的支持下，協康會租用了中心隔鄰的單位作擴充之用。隨著空間的擴展，中心增設了多感官室、多用途室、兩間小型訓練室，以及資源及玩具圖書館。除灣仔中心外，良景及白田早期教育及訓練中心亦先後進行了翻新工程。與此同時，為有效推行駐中心的言語治療服務，所有早期教育及訓練中心現已增設完善的言語治療室。上述的新設施均體現了協康會的服務宗旨，就是讓能力不同的兒童在愉快及健康的環境下盡展所能。

Enhancement of Children's Training

Major service reviews were conducted for both SCCCs and EETCs. Based on the results, together with parents' opinions collected through the Parents Satisfaction Surveys, changes in the service delivery mode were introduced. A better mix of group and individual training has been adopted in both SCCCs and EETCs. The increased use of group training not only facilitates children's learning under a dynamic, enjoyable and interactive atmosphere, but also better integrates the training elements of different disciplines. Much improvement was seen in children's learning and feedback from parents was encouraging.

To assist our teachers in their curriculum planning, the existing Developmental Assessment Chart, first developed in the mid-eighties, has been revised. The new assessment tool provides more information on the child's current status which serves as a bridge for curriculum planning. To ensure the quality of training, core programmes for children with different abilities and training needs are being developed. Upon completion, they will provide useful reference guide for the teachers and make the curriculum planning tasks more efficient and effective.

In line with the rising trend for integration, our programmes have been strengthened to further enhance children's social and communication skills, adjustment and adaptability to a normal school setting.

特殊幼兒中心和早期教育及訓練中心的服務檢討工作經已順利完成，參考了早前透過家長意見調查所搜集得的意見，我們改良了現行的服務模式。特殊幼兒中心和早期教育及訓練中心的小組訓練及個別輔導已重新組合，其中小組訓練的增加，不但讓兒童在輕鬆、愉快及互動的環境下學習，更有助融合不同的訓練元素，使兒童在學習方面有顯著的進步，而家長對這果效亦感到十分鼓舞。

於八十年代中初次訂定的發展評估表已完成修訂，全新的評估工具能為兒童的學習需要和進度提供更詳盡的資料，有助老師訂定課程訓練計劃。為確保訓練質素，我們現正為不同能力及需要的兒童設計核心課程，相信有關的課程將成為老師重要的參考資料，並有助提升課程訂定的效率及質素。

為配合融合教育的發展趨勢，我們將繼續致力透過各項訓練來提升兒童的社交和溝通，以及在普通小學就讀的適應能力。



Contingency Measures during the SARS Outbreak

During the early stage of the SARS outbreak, some vital SARS prevention items, such as face shields to be used when feeding children and conducting speech therapy, as well as children's toilet seat lids, were not available in the market. However, those items were critical for protecting our children and staff from the disease. To overcome the shortage, our staff used ingenuity to produce the prevention items themselves, with their own innovative ideas and the utilization of different materials. Fortunately, we were able to achieve zero infection in our centres.

centres were kept open for those parents and children needing occasional child care service or individual training. Outdoor activities were also arranged to help release the pressure on parents of combating the disease and taking care of their children. The role that parents played in stepping up the personal hygiene of the children, including training them to wear masks, was impressive. To better prepare for the possible recurrence of SARS, an After Action Review was conducted to consolidate good practices and identify areas for further improvement.

In the lengthy period of class suspension, staff maintained close contact with parents through phone calls to provide them with emotional support and understand the situation of their children. Home programmes were designed to maintain continuous training for the children. The cen-

在非典型肺炎爆發初期，不少抗炎物資的供應缺乏，其中包括同工在進行餵食及語言訓練時所用的防護面罩，以及專為小童而設的廁蓋等；然而，這些物資卻對預防學童及同工受感染尤其重要。於是我們同事在此危急時期發揮了無窮創意，善用各種資源以自製所需物資，使我們安然度過這段非典型襲港的日子。

在停課的七星期裡，員工不時致電與家長保持緊密聯絡，以了解兒童在家的情況及對家長給予情緒上的支援。我們亦設計了不少家居活動，讓兒童能得到持續的訓練。此外，本會在停課期間繼續開放轄下中心，為有需要的家長及兒童提供暫托服務或個別訓練。為紓緩家長在面對嚴峻疫情及照顧兒童的精神壓力，我們更安排了不少戶外活動，讓孩子與父母一同參與。至於家長方面，他們亦與我們一同努力，以確保子女的個人衛生，如悉心教導孩子使用口罩等，這教我們感到十分鼓舞。為預防非典型肺炎可能重現，我們已進行全面的事後檢討，以加強有效的應變措施和改善不足之處。



Strengthening of Parents' Participation

The Heep Hong Parents Association entered into its second year with pride and satisfaction. Not only did the enrollment of new members increase, many of them also played an active role in giving their views on various government policies. These included the fee charging for casualty and other specialist hospital services, the assessment service for children before admission to primary schools, and access for people with a disability. As far as self-help activities are concerned, four special groups were formed for children with autistic disorders, physical handicap, delayed development and those attending ordinary schools. Sharing sessions were organized to facilitate mutual support and exchange of experiences. As functioning of these four groups has become increasingly mature, some parents took the initiative to share their own experiences with new parents of similar background at the child assessment clinics.

Fathers have a significant role to play in helping children with special needs. However, they tend to be more reserved in sharing their feelings and experiences. Building upon the success of the Fathers' Club, our PRCs organized a Fathers' Forum in June 2003.

同心家長會的成立已踏入第二個年頭，美滿的成績令人驕傲。除會員的人數不斷上升外，當中更有不少會員積極就政府的政策發表意見，包括門診及專科醫療收費、小一入學前的評估服務，以及傷殘人士公共設施等。家長會亦致力促進家長的自助及互助精神，並特別為自閉症、肢體弱能、發展遲緩，以及入讀普通小學的四類有特殊需要兒童成立關注小組，透過舉辦分享會，讓家長可以互相扶持及分享經驗。該小組經不斷發展後已漸趨成熟，部份家長更主動到兒童評估中心，與背景相似的家長分享過來人的經驗。

Around 100 fathers attended. Guest speakers from the SWD and the Department of Social Work and Social Administration of the Hong Kong University, were invited to share their views on how to strengthen one's personal support network and handle stress. It is our belief that parents are our close partners and we will continue to involve them in every aspect of Heep Hong's work.

在有特殊需要兒童的成長過程中，父親也擔當著舉足輕重的角色；然而，他們對於表達自己的感受及與別人分享經驗卻往往難於啟齒。於是我們透過家長資源中心的「爸爸俱樂部」，於二零零三年六月舉行「爸爸論壇」，約有一百名父親參與，來自社會福利署及香港大學社會工作及社會行政學系的嘉賓講者亦應邀出席，與參加者分享如何鞏固個人支援網絡及面對生活壓力。我們深信家長是協康的親密合作夥伴，在未來會繼續致力鼓勵他們積極參與我們的工作。

Integrating into the Community

Facilitating the integration of our children into the community has been one of Heep Hong's main objectives. Since its establishment in March 2002, the Junior Gateway Club, which aims to promote integration between able and disabled children, has built up a membership of around 2,500. In the past year, over 700 programmes have been organized on Saturdays and during long holidays, which were attended by approximately 18,000 children and parents from the centres and their neighbouring communities. The Gateway activities provide a platform for both groups to play and learn in a natural environment. Volunteers from all walks of life, including employees from major corporations, students and housewives, have offered their assistance.

To further strengthen the social interaction between these two groups, each of our Centres had organized integration programmes with at least one ordinary child care centre / kindergarten in their neighbourhood. Around 40 child care centres and kindergartens were involved in these programmes during the past year, thereby contributing to a more inclusive community.

融入社區

協康會的其中一項重點工作，就是協助有特殊需要兒童融入社群。為推廣有特殊需要兒童與朋輩間的融洽相處，協康會於二零零二年三月成立了兒童健樂會，現時的會員人數已多達二千五百人。去年我們更舉辦了超過七百項周末及長假期的活動，吸引了約一萬八千名來自協康會轄下多間中心及區內兒童的參與。兒童健樂會的活動實能為兒童提供一起遊戲和學習的機會，同時，亦提供予來自社會各階層的義工，包括大機構的僱員、學生和家庭主婦，一個慷慨助人的機會。

為進一步促進兒童間的共融關係，協康會轄下的中心均曾與區內最少一所幼兒中心或幼稚園合辦融合活動。去年，曾與我們合作的幼兒中心及幼稚園約有四十間，共同為建立傷健共融的社會而努力。

為了加深公眾對本會兒童的認識，超過五十項地區宣傳活動於二零零二至零三年度展開。本會的专业治療隊伍更曾在多個活動上為學前兒童提供免費的評估服務及給予家長

To enhance the public's understanding of our services and the special needs of our children, over 50 district promotion programmes were organized in the year 2002 / 03. In some of these programmes, our therapist teams offered free screening services to pre-school children and advice to their parents. Such activities proved to be useful as we were able to identify children who require special attention, and give timely guidance to their parents.

In addition, a number of major corporations and their employees participated in our fund raising events in the year, including "The 12th Great Chefs of Hong Kong" and "Charity Walk cum Christmas Carnival 2002". This kind of active interaction with the children and their parents enhanced these corporations' support to Heep Hong on a continuous basis.

New Initiatives in the Supportive Learning Project

Apart from all the development in our “traditional” services, the self-financing Supportive Learning Project (SLP) underwent a challenging but fruitful year too. Recognizing the worthiness of the Project, The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust started to sponsor part of its operational cost for three years from April 2003. The sponsorship came right in time to help us to pursue some new initiatives, such as the case manager approach.

During the year under review, lots of efforts were put into developing new service packages to cater for the various needs of our service users. Among them, the package on a training programme for children with writing difficulties was well received by 48 schools involving a total of 1,500 participating children, parents and teachers. To enhance the public's understanding of the subject and the difficulties that such children are facing, a booklet was published and a press conference was held in June 2003. In view of the positive and encouraging response, our professional staff will continue to explore solutions to different service gap areas.

Meantime, efforts were also put into developing new cooperation modes with different schools, organizations and

除了繼續發展我們的「傳統」服務外，青蔥計劃仍以自負盈虧的模式運作，並在去年種種挑戰下取得豐碩的成果。該計劃所提供的服務備受香港賽馬會慈善信託基金的認同，並由二零零三年四月起獲贊助部份營運經費，為期三年。這項贊助正好配合青蔥計劃未來的嶄新發展，包括落實個案管理的推行。



在過去一年，我們致力推出全新的服務計劃，以照顧服務使用者的不同需要。其中專為有書寫困難兒童而設的訓練，更成功地在四十八間學校推行，共有一千五百名學童、家長及教師參與。為了提升公眾人士對兒童書寫困難的認識，我們更編製了一本以此為題的小冊子，以及於二零零三年六月舉行了記者招待會。由於是次成績美滿，計劃內的同工將繼續從事探討各種尚待鑽研的專題，從而為有需要的兒童及其家長，以及老師帶來裨益。

此外，我們亦竭力與不同的學校、組織和機構發展嶄新的合作模式。於去年，使用

corporations. Last year, there were more schools using our service for teachers' training and parents' talks. To reach out to a diversified group of potential users, we developed strategic partnerships with The Hong Kong Professional Teachers' Union and other private sector companies for the organization of various functions. With the increasing popularity of the Project among parents and professionals, there was more media coverage of our programmes and staff of SLP were often asked to render their expert opinion on different topics relating to child development.

Despite the achievements made in the past year, there is still much room for further expansion of this innovative Project. In light of heightened awareness of children with learning difficulties in primary schools, the provision of direct service to mainstream education schools will remain our major development target in coming years. Nevertheless, to enhance the overall development of children and to assist their parents / teachers and the public in understanding their needs and the challenges they may encounter during their growing years will continue to be the main objectives of SLP in the long run.

縱然去年的成績超卓，青蔥計劃的發展前路仍是十分漫長。我們未來的重點工作將是為主流學校提供直接的服務，從而提升大眾對就讀於普通小學而有學習困難的兒童的關注。而青蔥計劃的長遠目標，則是致力提升兒童的整體發展，幫助他們的家長、老師，以至社會大眾認識兒童在成長過程中的種種需要和挑戰。

Work across the Border

While our regular programmes and projects have been running successfully here in Hong Kong, we are also keen to share the Heep Hong experience with our counterparts in other Chinese communities, with a view to bring better lives to hundreds and thousands of afflicted children elsewhere.

The project with the Shanghai Children's Home was completed satisfactorily in December 2002. It proceeded smoothly and the results were appreciated by the Home. The project was highly commended by Dr Shi Derong, the former Director of the Civil Affairs Bureau, for improving knowledge and technical skills, as well as widening the horizons and the ways of thinking of the staff of the Home. In view of the positive result, the Home has continued to send their staff to Heep Hong to undergo different training programmes.

跨境工作

當我們為本地兒童所提供的服務得到順利發展的同時，我們亦期望能在其他華人社區與同業分享經驗，從而造福世界各地的兒童。

我們與上海市兒童福利院的合作計劃已於二零零二年十二月圓滿結束。該項計劃不僅進行順利，而成效更得到院方的高度評價。前上海市民政局局长施德容博士更極度推崇該項計劃，指計劃能有效協助提升院內同工的知識和技巧，以及擴闊他們的眼界和思想領域。由於成效顯著，上海市兒童福利院其後亦繼續安排院內同工來港接受各項培訓。

另外，我們十分感謝希望之友教育基金有限公司慷慨贊助廣州中山大學附屬第三醫院的培訓課程，該項目已於二零零三年順利完成，來自廣州各個機構及中心的業內同工均參與了四個階段的自閉症兒童訓練基礎課程。

我們除了為國內同業提供培訓課程外，同時亦為台灣多個機構安排有關結構化教學法的培訓活動。其中十二名來自台灣特殊學校的教師，於二零零二年年底參與為期七天的基礎課程，透過講課、討論及實習，接受了理論與實踐兼備的教學訓練，而各學員對課程的內容和安排均感非常滿意。中華啟智工作人員協會秘書長王秉哲先生更在該會的會訊中盛讚本會同工的熱誠態

(Guangzhou) was also completed satisfactorily in 2003. All the four stages of the Foundation Course for Training of Autistic Children were conducted, with practitioners from different agencies / centres in Guangzhou participating in the training.

Apart from training programmes offered to our Mainland counterparts, courses on the TEACCH (Training and Education of Autistic and related Communication handicapped Children) programme were also arranged for organizations in Taiwan. In late 2002, a total of twelve teachers from special schools and training centres came to Hong Kong to attend the one-week Foundation Course, which incorporates both theory and practice, intensively delivered in the form of lectures, class discussions and placement. All participants were satisfied with the programmes and the arrangement. Mr Wong Bing Che, the Chief Secretary of the Taiwan Kai Chi Association, expressed in their newsletter that they were very impressed by our enthusiasm and open attitude.

In view of the success of such training courses, more of them will be organized in different formats to meet the rising demand. We look forward to collaborating with our counterparts elsewhere to help with improvement of quality of service for children with special needs and their parents.

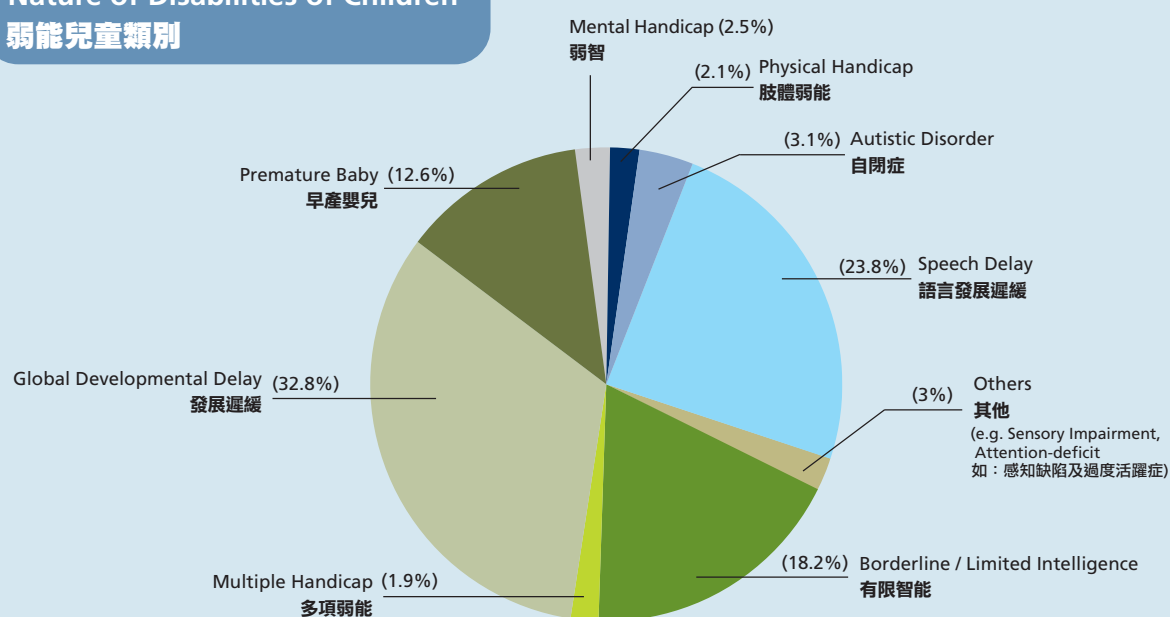

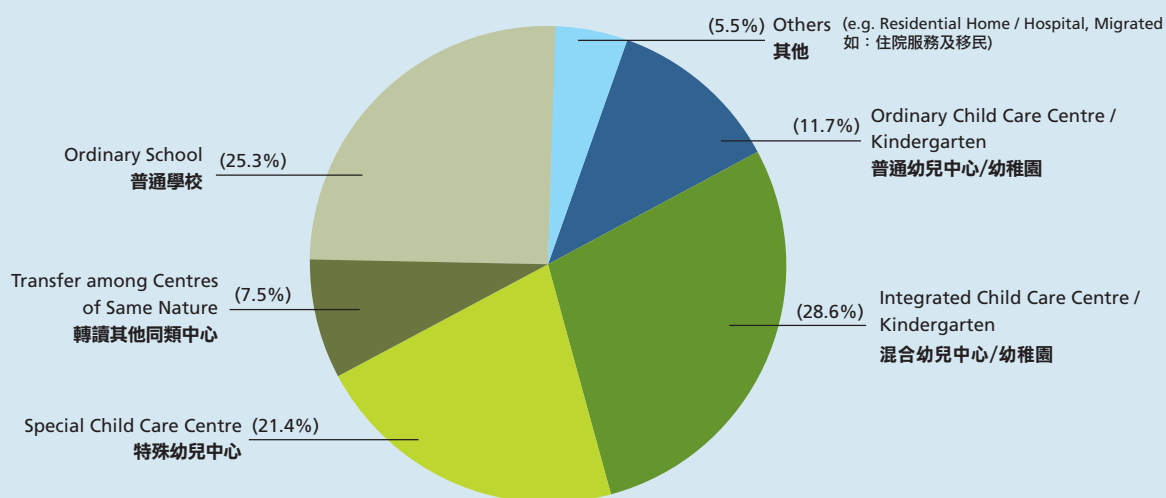

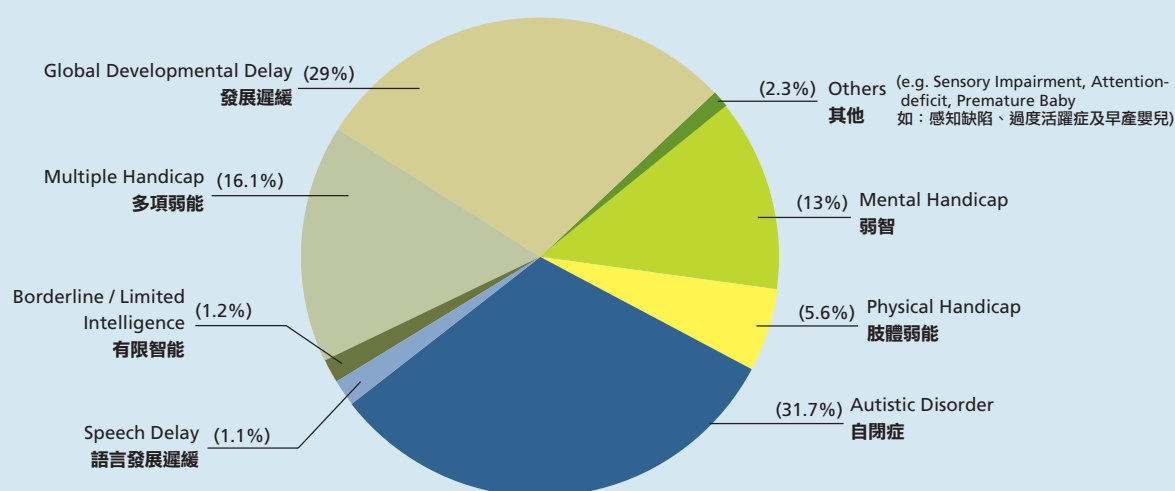
Placement of Children after Leaving Centres 兒童離開中心後的安置

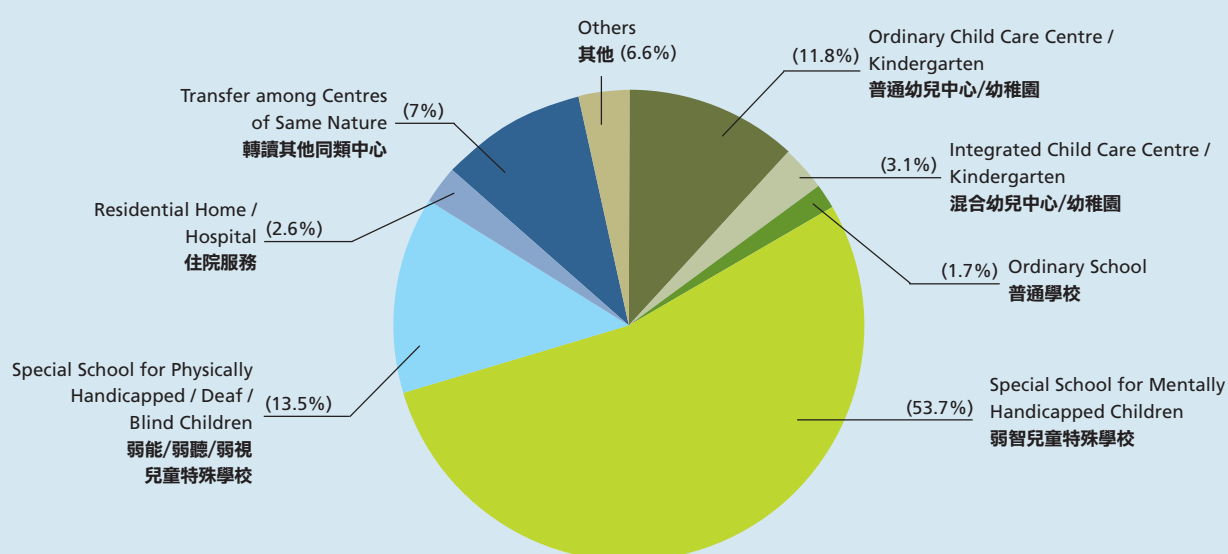

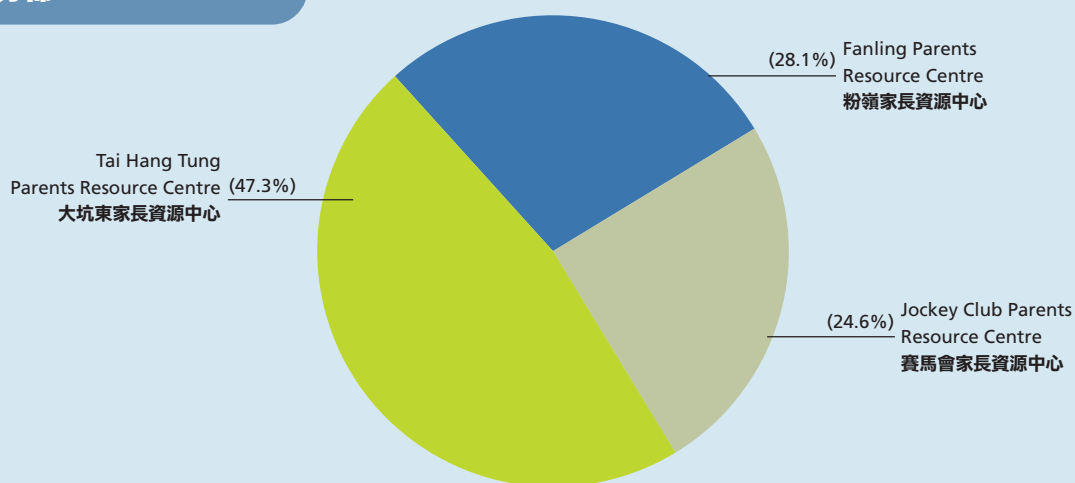
Placement of Children after Leaving Centres 兒童離開中心後的安置

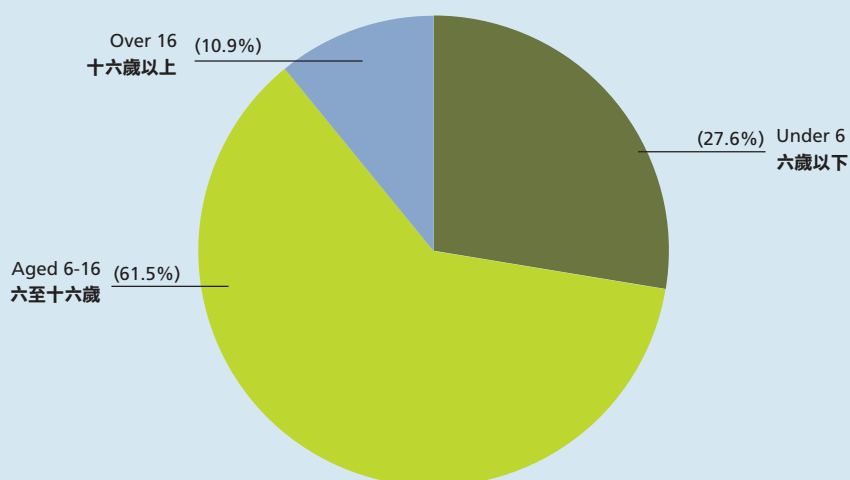

Distribution of Members 會員分佈



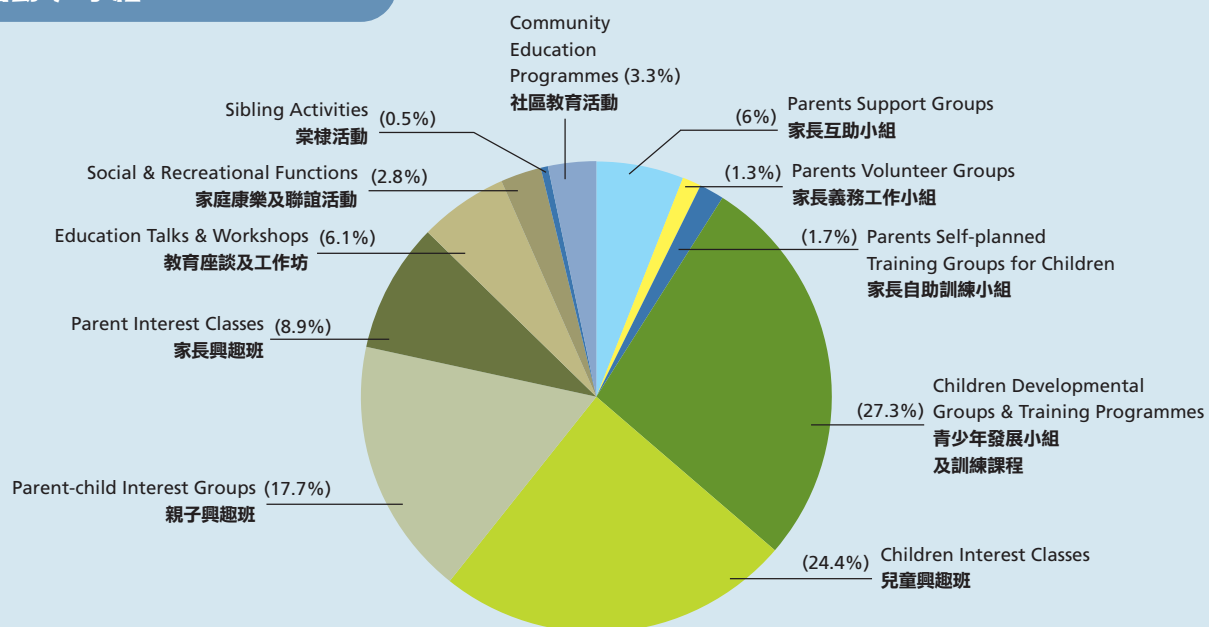

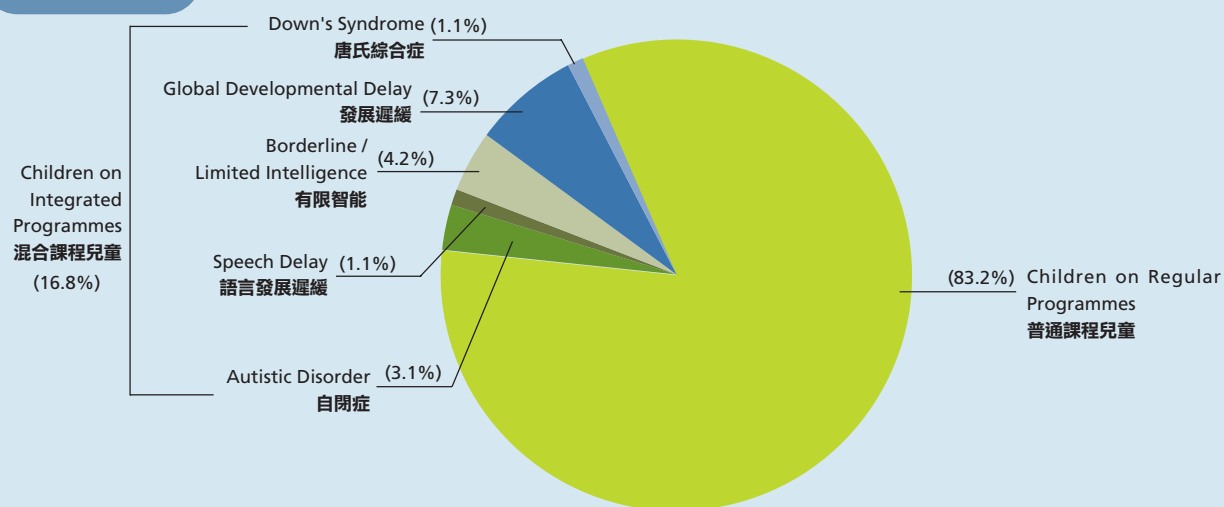

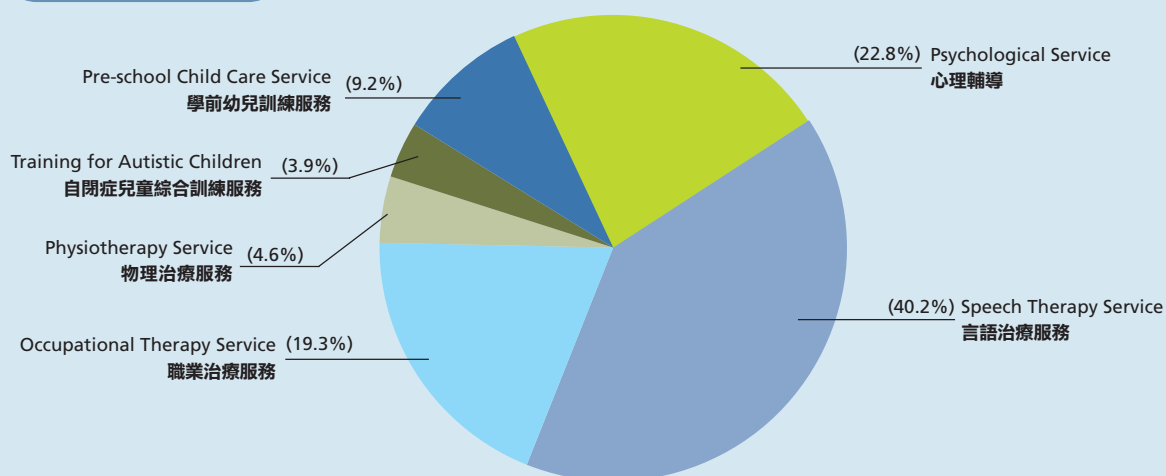

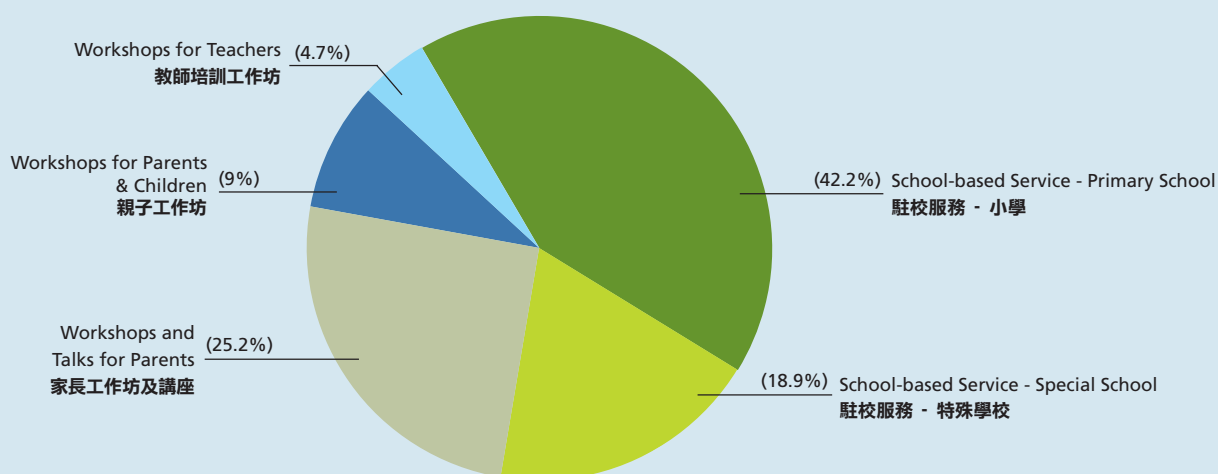

60s - Embryo Stage

Heep Hong was founded when a group of Hong Kong women became concerned with the lack of post-operative care for children recovering from poliomyelitis and began to take them out for recreational activities in the early 60s.

Initially, it was only possible to provide activities once a week at the Sandilands Girl Guides Hut. Afterwards, our service base was moved to the old Sports Pavilion at the Sir Lindsay Ride Centre at The University of Hong Kong, and the service was expanded to Kowloon at the Girl Guides Hut and later to the Merchant Navy Sports Ground.

During this period, the service mainly relied on donations from the community. In 1969, we became a member of the Community Chest and started to receive subvention from the Social Welfare Department.

六十年代 - 協康會的雛型

協康會的成立，正值六十年代小兒麻痺症肆虐之際。當時患病的兒童於離院後一般缺乏照顧，一群熱心婦女遂為這些兒童提供定期的康樂活動及訓練，給予他們心靈上的鼓勵。

起初，本會主要借用香港女童軍總會會所每星期舉行一次活動。及後服務擴展至九龍，並借用女童軍九龍分會會所提供服務，後轉往商船海員球場；而港島區方面，則遷往香港大學賴廉士舊體育館舉行活動。

本會成立之初，經費來源主要靠社會人士捐助。至1969年，始為香港公益金的首批成員，並接受社會福利署的津助。

“協康會已踏入四十周年，我十分榮幸以創會成員的身份，見證著機構的誕生與成長。最令我感到欣慰及鼓舞的，就是協康會經歷了多年的努力耕耘後，至今已茁壯成長，深得各界認同，而全體同工亦能上下一心，讓孩子在愉快的學習環境下盡展所能。

猶記得協康會還未成立時，一名熱心的醫務社工鄭瑞珍女士（後為協康會的創辦人之一）眼見患上小兒麻痺症的兒童基於身體的缺陷，未能與其他小朋友一起上學、遊戲，於是她便引領我和一班義工太太，每逢周末為這群兒童安排康樂活動，好讓他們舒展身心，同時享受學習的樂趣。我們除了擔任義務導師外，還要充當司機，接載這些兒童參與活動。當時社會並不十分富裕，孩子乘車的機會不多，所以在路途上不時有兒童感到暈眩不適，甚至嘔吐大作。有一次，一位義工太太如常駕車接載孩子出外活動時，途中後座的孩子忽然嘔吐，並將她吐得滿頭骯髒；然而，這位太太並沒有絲毫不悅或埋怨，反而繼續為孩子

服務，努力為他們帶來愉快的童年生活。雖然這個三十多年前的故事似乎相當遙遠，但我仍記憶猶新，這是因為今天的協康會員工依然一如既往，上下一心，致力為兒童服務。”

Society's Committee for 30 years before I retired and I witnessed its development from a fairly small club to the largest provider of pre-school service in Hong Kong, with its contribution extending well beyond Hong Kong to neighbouring Chinese communities. But one thing that has not changed and which always stands out in my mind is the Heep Hong Society's dedicated spirit in serving children with special needs! ”

70s - Pioneer of Special Child Care Service

In the 70s, poliomyelitis almost disappeared and we accepted children with different kinds of disabilities including physical handicaps and mental handicaps. In 1971, we established our own centre in Sandy Bay, while the second one started its operation at Ho Man Tin, Kowloon in 1976. With professional services provided, the two centres were registered with the Social Welfare Department under the Child Care Centres Ordinance, and we became a pioneer pre-school special education provider for children aged 2-6.

In the mid 70s, we participated in the review of the Rehabilitation Programme Plan and advocated the introduction of early intervention to newborn babies.

七十年代- 開創特殊幼兒服務的先驅

隨著小兒麻痺症日漸減少，協康會把服務對象擴展至弱能及弱智的兒童，並在1971年於香港大口環率先成立第一所訓練中心，服務也漸趨專業化。及後於1976年再在九龍何文田邨成立第二所中心。至1977年，該兩個服務單位正式登記註冊為特殊幼兒中心，開創了香港為2-6歲兒童提供正規學前特殊教育服務的先河。

七十年代中期，本會參與了「康復服務白皮書」的諮詢工作，並率先倡導將幼兒復康服務提前至初生嬰孩。

“I came to Hong Kong in October 1969, newly married and totally new to Asia. With me I brought the names of friends of friends whom it had been suggested that I make contact with. The first one I rang up was Margaret Ashworth, who was an early volunteer with Heep Hong and she invited me to come along and help.

The Hong Kong centre was then operating at the pavilion of the Hong Kong University Sports Ground in Pokfulam and that is where I started out as a volunteer. Not having seen many post-polio cases before, I remember at first feeling sorry for the children having to "struggle" all the way from the car park across the sports field to the pavilion with their callipers and crutches, but they were so lively and full of energy, that I quite quickly saw them as just another bunch of kids, wanting to have fun, play games and learn new things along the way. At that time, I and many of the other volunteers, spoke little or no Cantonese, but it didn't seem too difficult to communicate with the children. Maybe our

mistakes in pronunciation added to their amusement and hugs and laughter are a universal language.

I enjoyed working with those children in the 70s as much as I do with the ones at Healthy Kids Centre today, but my status has now changed from "Big Sister" to "Grandma".”

80s - Expansion of Services to Newborns

At the beginning of the 80s, Heep Hong participated in the Government's Working Party on Pre-school Care, Education and Training of Disabled Children (WOPSCET) and started to operate Early Education and Training Centres providing early intervention to children aged 0-6 and their parents. Home based service was also offered for children who were unable to go to the centres for training.

Heep Hong expanded rapidly in the 80s. A number of Special Child Care Centres were opened in line with the recommendations of WOPSCET. To meet service demand, we employed different professionals to serve the children, as well as promoting parents' participation which resulted in the establishment of The Parents' Association of Pre-School Handicapped Children.

To further enhance our service, we published the Developmental Learning Package aimed at providing systematic assessment and training for children with special needs. It was well received and adopted by many early childhood special educators.

八十年代- 引入早期教育及訓練服務

八十年代初期，本會參與了政府的「學前弱能兒童教育及訓練工作小組」，並開辦為0-6歲幼兒及其家人提供早期介入的「早期教育及訓練中心」，而該服務更延伸至外展家居訓練，以照顧未能到中心接受訓練的兒童。

在這十年間，本會的服務可謂踏入了「擴展期」。為配合上述「工作小組」的建議，我們陸續開辦了多間特殊幼兒中心，並積極招聘專業人才，推動家長運動，籌組「學前弱能兒童家長會」。

為提升服務水平，本會出版了《兒童訓練指南》，以有系統的評估及訓練工具幫助家長及學前特殊教育人士訓練兒童，廣為業界採納。

「太極有陰、有陽，陰陽互相配合，才有和諧，但是患有自閉症的人卻把陰和陽分得清清楚楚，永遠沒有中間部份，因此，不易被別人接受。」

跟我說這段話的，並不是研究自閉症的專家，而是我這快將十六歲的自閉症兒子－仲賢。這十多年來，我為他流過不少眼淚，為的不是抱怨他患有自閉症，而是在面對種種精神壓力下，情緒上難免要宣洩一下。仲賢從小就在主流學校讀書，期間我時刻擔心他不能適應群體生活；然而，我的兒子並沒有令我失望，他現在已是一個中五學生，在很多方面跟一般青年人沒有分別，他懂得重視學業，期盼得到別人公開的讚賞，他還懂得關心和愛護別人。

回想起當仲賢兩歲時，他被評估為過度活躍及語言遲緩，在協康會砵蘭街早期教育及訓練中心接受訓練。那裡的導師幫助我認識仲賢的潛能和限制，更讓我們這些家長學習教導孩子的方法，這給我帶來了很多的啟發。我理解兒子在表達方面所遇到的困難，也深刻體

會到他有口難言之苦。所以我特別用心去聽他的話，並鼓勵他以任何方法表達自己。

要走的路還是很長，我抱著戰戰兢兢的心情去面對未來的挑戰。幸好，與我結伴同行的還有「學前弱能兒童家長會」的一群好友；不過，最令我感動的是協康會這十多年來對我的支持，使我能以正面積極的態度陪伴兒子一起成長。

90s - Inception of Parents Resource Centres

Support and care from parents are extremely important for the growth and development of children with special needs. However, parents themselves, at the same time, suffer from immense pressure when taking care of their children. Heep Hong, therefore, pioneered the operation of two Parents Resource Centres in Kowloon and New Territories in the early 90s providing a wide range of supportive services. This idea was recognized by the Government and subvention has been given to the centres since 1994.

To promote integrated education, Heep Hong started to operate an ordinary child care centre with integrated programme for children with mild disability.

On research and development, Heep Hong contributed by publishing a number of practical training tools including the Training Package for Autistic Children. The Package, published in 1997, was the first publication in Chinese introducing the "Structured Teaching" method for training autistic children. We also began sharing our experience with our rehabilitation counterparts in the Mainland and Taiwan.

九十年代- 創辦家長資源中心的服務

弱能兒童的成長，全賴家長的悉心照顧與支持，但在育兒的過程中，這些家長難免要面對比一般家長更沉重的壓力。有見及此，本會於九十年代初期在九龍及新界率先開辦了兩所家長資源中心，為有特殊需要兒童的家長提供全面的支援，其服務價值獲得政府的肯定，並於1994年獲批資助。

為推廣融合教育，本會更開辦了一所設有兼收學位的幼兒中心，讓傷健兒童有機會一同學習和成長。

在兒童訓練方面，本會先後推出多套實用教材，其中包括於1997年出版了全國首套的《自閉症兒童訓練指南》，為自閉症兒童提供結構化教學，成效顯著。本會亦於九十年代開始與國內及台灣同業分享我們的經驗，並為他們的同工提供培訓。

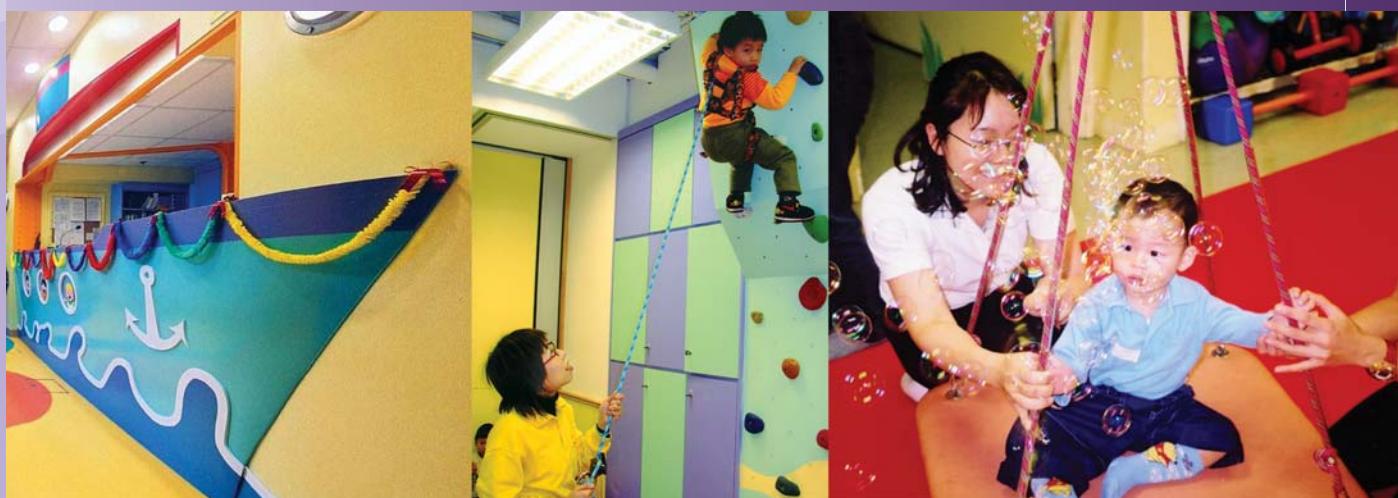

The New Millennium - New Initiatives

In the new millennium, Heep Hong has launched the innovative Supportive Learning Project which aims at providing quality professional services to parents, teachers and students with learning difficulties studying in primary schools. The Project offers an alternative for parents seeking help from subvented services or private consultants.

Heep Hong has also operated the first mixed-mode centre in Hong Kong providing joint special child care service and early education and training service. Different kinds of mixed-mode centres will be developed in the near future to provide one-stop comprehensive service.

To further empower our parents, Heep Hong Parents Association was established in 2001 to encourage parents' participation in formulating our service policy. In this new century, we will continue to work closely with different rehabilitation organizations in the Mainland and other places to bring needed services to a greater number and wider range of children.

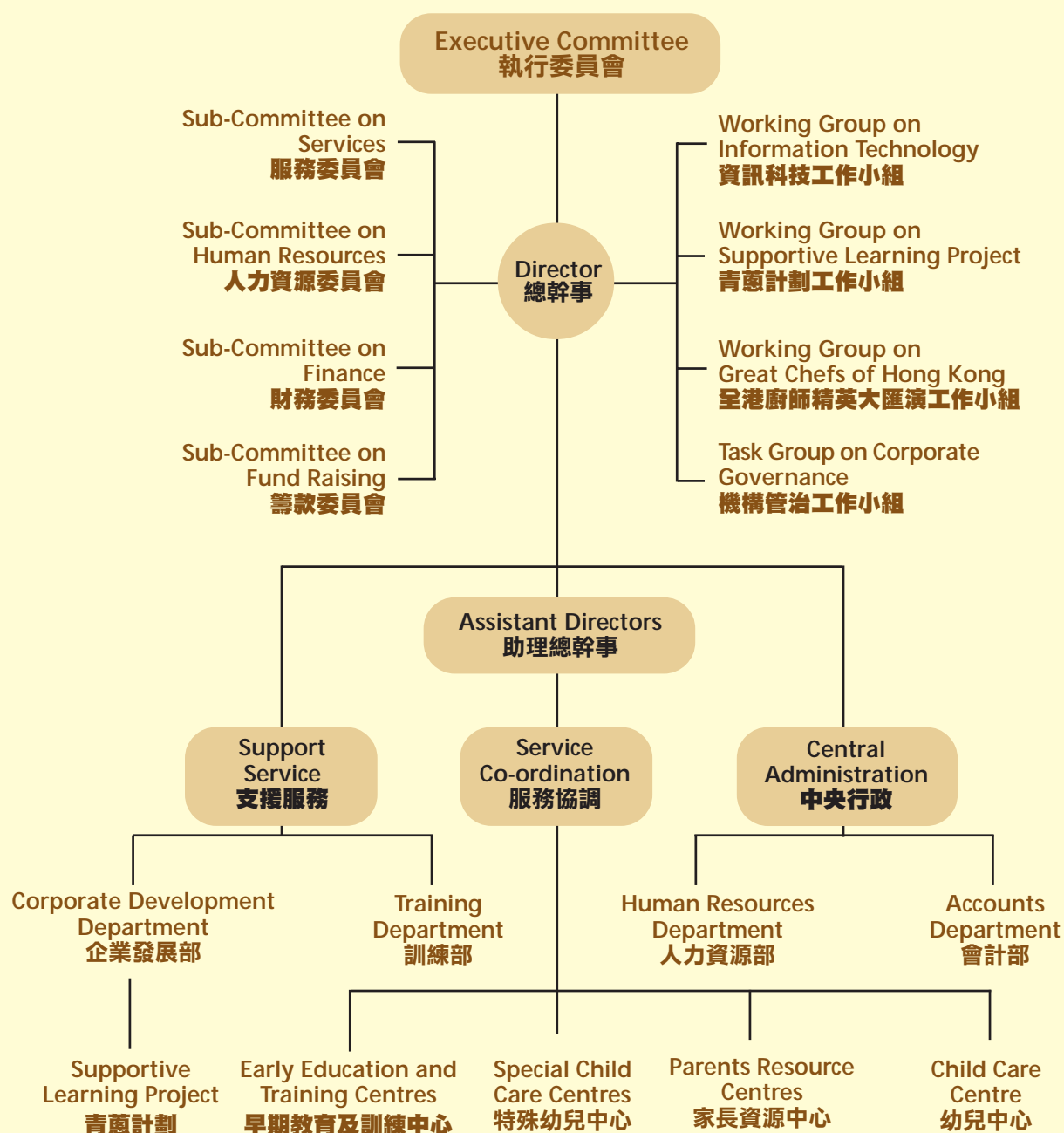

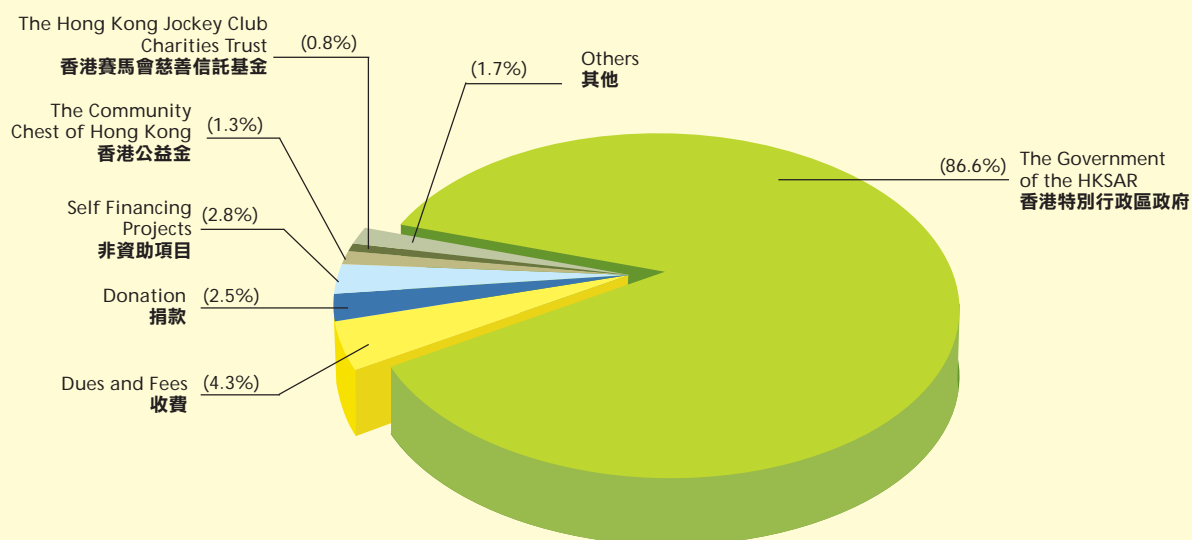

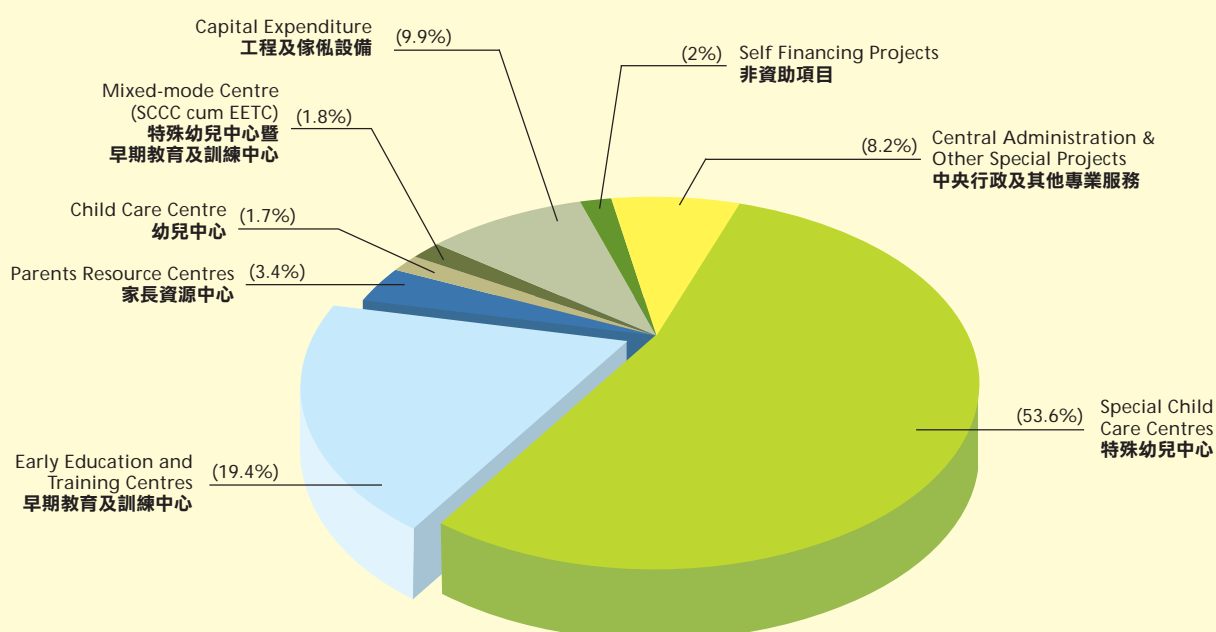
